Ross & District Motor Sports Club will run the nineteenth 'Bluebell Run' on Saturday 11th May 2019. The 'Bluebell Run' is, as usual, part of the Historic Rally Car Register (HRCR) Scenic Tour series. The 'Bluebell Run' is a non competitive scenic tour for Classic Vehicles more than 25 years old. We do accept other "interesting" younger vehicles at the organisers' discretion.

The run will start from Hopewell Colliery Museum & Working Mine (www.hopewellcolliery.com), deep in the Forest of Dean where we will use the excellent café run by an old friend of the 'Bluebell Run' where you will find plenty of good parking with the café serving homemade full breakfasts, snacks and drinks.

For this year we have a new finish venue at Penyard House Hotel at Weston under Penyard just 3 miles from Ross-on-Wye. An up-market, two course hot evening meal will be served. We hope the weather will allow you to enjoy the gardens and outside seating areas in the garden of this beautiful old hotel whilst you unwind and chat about the days run.

We offer a well organised scenic tour of around 120 miles through the Forest of Dean, Wye Valley and the Welsh Marches. The set route will guarantee great scenery, wonderful views and good quiet driving roads.

The 'Bluebell Run' is open to all. No Club membership or competition licence is required. It is a non competitive event; you **should not** require any special insurance for your car. It is an opportunity to drive your pre 1994 'pride and joy' on a picturesque route in the company of other enthusiastic like minded souls.

Included in the entry fee, for a crew of two, is morning coffee, a ploughman's lunch at a lovely country pub, a full two course hot meal at the finish at the hotel, a rigid "rally plate" and two good quality souvenir awards. We are renowned for offering a very good value event.

The route will be detailed in an easy to follow "**Tulip**" Style road book, produced to World Rally Championship quality, which includes some maps, together with notes on places of interest that you pass. The objective of our comprehensive road book is for you to easily follow the correct route. We also allow plenty of time for you to "stop and look." We have been over subscribed for the previous seven 'Bluebell Run's' so you are advised to get your entry in early. Entry fee is expected to be in the region of £90.00
