Welcome to the Ross Traders Trophy Rally

This year's rally will have a very different look from previous years.

It is the first round of the HRCR Historic Road Rally Championship 2020, and will run on the 1st February 2020.

The event is centred at Caerwent and is a day / evening event.

Approximately 30 Miles of special Tests, mixed with 60 miles of regularity and 40 road miles. The finish is at Ross Motor Club as always.

Scrutineering and noise will start at Caerwent in the morning around 9.00, with the 1st car being flagged away by the very first winner of the Traders at 12.30.

Tests and regularities in and around Caerwent will follow with a break/ rest halt around 16.30.

After some well-earned food and rest, three more tests in Caerwent, followed by regularities which will take you back to the finish in Ross-on-Wye at approximately 20.30, where results, supper and awards will be presented.

There will be a catering van at Caerwent for those who would like breakfast. Lunch and supper is included in the entry fee of **£150**.

The Traders has a new Clerk of Course this year, with some old and new helpers/organisers supporting him.

The team feel that the new format will be as good a test, as any of the previous Traders Rallies in the past.

The Traders Rally is known to be a tough test for the driver and the navigator, this year will be no exception.

Regulations and the entry form will be available from early November.
