These are not the standard regs for this event, so please read these carefully.

- 1. Ross and District Motor Sports Ltd will organise a Treasure Hunt on Friday, 30th October 2020.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the Sporting Code of the FIA), by these Supplementary Regulations, and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event.
- 3. Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption 118165 has been issued. C&T route authorisation is not required.
- 4. The event is open to all members and friends of the Organising Club. It is not a requirement of this event for all participants to have a competition licence. Any crew member not from the same household as the other(s) must wear a close-fitting facemask in the car. All participants must wear a close-fitting facemask at the start and finish venues.
- 5. Entries open on publication of these Regulations. Entries can only be made electronically on the official entry form. Complete the form on screen, save it and then e-mail it as an attachment to the secretary of the event. simonharris8@outlook.com

Entries close at **1900 on Tuesday 27th October**, and Final Instructions will be emailed out. These will include the Final Instructions and the pre-event declaration (to be completed and returned).

Returned pre-event declarations must be received by the secretary before 1800 on Thursday 29th October.

The entry fee of £7.00 must be paid in cash (exact money only – no change given) at the start.

At the finish, timecards must be deposited into a plastic pocket which will be supplied at the finish.

- 7. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:-
 - 1940 Start venue gate opens
 - 2000 Start Time from the start.
 - 2200 Closing time of Finish.
- 8. The start will be at the Secretary's house (address above) Map Reference 162/725239. An arrow will indicate the drive entrance. The route will be not more than 20 miles. The correct route is the shortest distance on yellow class roads or above, following the information given on the route card. Ordnance Survey Landranger 1:50,000 Maps 162 will be required.
- 9. There will be no classes.

- 10. Crews will receive their timecard and route cards at the same start time in sanitised envelopes.
- 11. There will be a Main Control at the start and at the end of the event.

 There will be Route Checks at various points along the correct route.

 At these points, a code board will be placed. The onus is on the competitor to record the letters/numbers on the board onto the time card.
- 12. For each missed Route Check
 Arriving at the finish Main Control after due time
 Arriving at the finish Main Control before due time
 Wrong approach to the finish Main Control

plus 10 Marks plus 5 Marks per min No penalty/No Marks plus 20 marks

- 13. The winning crew will have the least number of penalties. Any ties for position will be resolved by reference to 'furthest cleanest', with regard to correct RC's.
- 14. Results will be announced as soon as possible after the end of the event. There will be no awards.
- 15. All vehicles must be road legal.
