### Competitor Bulletin 1

Thank you for your prompt support in entering the Hatsford Targa.

Signing on is open. Please follow the link (top right) on the MTC1 Entry List webpage. The link will take you to their usual signing on page.

Also you will need to upload photographs (in JPG or PDF format) of your Competition Licences for both crew members (Interclub or Clubman as appropriate) and your Club Cards. If you are joining the Ross Club to do the event, then you will get your Club Card in your rally pack on the day, and you obviously can't take a photo of it. However, I will have seen your card, so that's OK. Once both crew members have signed on and uploaded photos correctly, then I will add "Yes" to the entry list (right hand column). This is not automatic – I will add the "Yes" once the procedures have been completed, and I'll check them every day or so. Please ensure you sign on and upload the photos as guided through the Entry List system. If you think you've signed on and uploaded the photos and you don't get a "Yes" in a day or so, then you haven't done it correctly. Contact me for advice. If you try to log in after the seeding has been done, you will need to use your seeded number instead of your Entry Number. Please note the closing date of accessing the signing on system. Do it now before you forget!

If you are bringing a marshal (thank you, we appreciate your support) please ensure that they sign on as soon as possible. This will help in the event planning as far as stationing marshals is concerned. The link to Marshals signing on is on our Hatsford Targa webpage on our Club website.
