

## RUN TO THE MOON

19th March 2026

1. Ross and District Motor Sports Limited will organise a Treasure Hunt on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2026
2. The meeting will be held under the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the Sporting Code of the FIA), by these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising club may issue for this event.
3. A Motorsport UK Permit numbered: 206707 has been issued. The event is not subject to Competition and Trials route authorisation.
4. The event is open to all members and friends of Ross and District Motorsport Club; participants do not need a competition licence.
5. **Entries** open on publication of these Regulations and can be made electronically on the official entry form. Complete the form on screen or on paper, then e-mail as an attachment to the Secretary of the event, Richard McLachlan; [richmcl@mcrally.co.uk](mailto:richmcl@mcrally.co.uk)
  - a. Entries close **sharp at 19:00 on Tuesday 17th March** and brief Final Instructions will be e-mailed out. Participants will sign-on in the traditional way at the Start.
  - b. The **entry fee** of **£8.00** must be paid in cash beforehand or at the Start (in exact money).
  - c. If there are fewer than **five** Entries on 17<sup>th</sup> March, the event will not run.

7. The **programme** of the meeting will be as follows:-
  - a. **19:30** Start venue opens for Sign-on, then crews' briefing at 19:45
  - b. **19:55** Route issued and official Start Time.
  - c. **22:00** Closing time of finish (arrive by this time to be classed as a finisher).
8. The **Start** is in Ross & District Motor Sports Club at 25 Kyrle Street, Ross-on-Wye, HR9 7DB. O.S. map ref **162 / 600 243**. Please use the two car parks in Kyrle St.
9. The **Finish** is at The Moon public house in Garway village. O.S. map ref **161 / 465 227**. The Finish Control is in "The Snug" which is on the right hand side as you enter the pub. Please do show your appreciation to The Moon by giving them some custom.
10. Ordnance Survey Landranger **Map 161** and **Map 162** are required along with pencils and a roamer. The correct route is less than 21 miles (average speed <10mph) and is the shortest distance on yellow classification roads or above, following the information in the Route Instructions.
11. There are no classes or awards, and the event does not form part of any championship. This is purely for fun as a navigational test, where the skill or experience of the driver plays no part.
12. Three levels of navigation will be provided, to provide a challenge for more experienced crews. At any point, a crew may ask for a different level of navigation should they wish to try the harder or easier navigation.
13. **Vehicles** must be road legal with road tax and MOT (where applicable), must have effective silencers, and not present a PR risk (in the opinion of the officials).
14. **Drivers** must hold appropriate insurance for the event and drive courteously at all times in full compliance with speed limits and road signs, being especially conscious of residents on route.
15. Crews all receive their Route Instructions and Route Card at the 19:55 Start time. Crews then plot in Clubhouse or car as they wish and depart in their own time.
16. **Controls and Route Checks;**
  - a. There will be a Main Control at the start and at the finish of the event.
  - b. There will be Route Checks at various points along the correct route.
  - c. At these Route Checks, a code board or marshal will be placed. The onus is on the competitor to record the letters/numbers on the board onto the time card, or collect a signature from the marshal.
17. **Penalties:**

- a. For each missed Route Check plus 10 marks
- b. Wrong Approach at a Route Check plus 10 marks
- c. Arriving at the finish Main Control before due time no penalty
- d. Arriving at the finish Main Control after due time classed as none-finisher

18. Performance will be assessed by total number of penalties. Any ties for position will be resolved by 'furthest cleanest', with regard to correct Route Checks.

19. **Results** will be announced as soon as possible after the end of the event.
