Final Instructions

If you cannot take part in the run, please advise on 07979 333309 a.s.a.p. as we have reserves waiting.

The entry list is attached with your start number. The Start of the run is at **The Larruperz Centre, Ross-on-Wye, HR9 7QD. What 3 Words location ///save.system.roadshow OS: 162/ 605 242**

Upon arrival, park neatly in the car park, go and sign-on to receive your paperwork and refreshments from 08.00 (tea/coffee and bacon roll), then fix the souvenir event number plate to the front of your car with the two cable ties provided.

The Clerk of the Course's mobile 07467 546387 will be on from about 07:00 if you have a problem. This mobile is usually always turned on.

There are fuel stations on the event route which are identified in the Road Book. The nearest one to the start is at Morrison's about 200 meters from the start. The nearest to the Finish is Texaco, The Homend, Ledbury HR8 1BS (W3W: ///lawn.range.redouble) or Gulf Fuel, A417, Ledbury HR8 2JD (///troubles.object.presented). **Recommendation**, start the run with a full tank.

Please **arrive by 08.40** in time for the drivers briefing. To calculate your start time, add your competition number in minutes to 09.00.

The following documents may be required for inspection: Current vehicle MOT Certificate, where applicable, for the car being used.

There will be a Driver's Briefing at 08:45, which all participants should attend.

There will be a photographer out taking pictures. Please smile and wave.

If you are caught by cars following you, please pull over and let them pass as soon as possible as some drivers like to go a little quicker than others.

The evening buffet at the finish (Ledbury Rugby Club, HR8 2LP, W3W location: ///richest.boasted.growth) OS: 149 /699 367 will not be served before 16.45 at the earliest, so please do not rush back.

We would like to remind you that this is a scenic tour, not a race. Adequate time has been allowed to travel the route at a touring pace, with extra time to stop at various viewpoints and places of interest.

Please note the following: The first car will leave the morning coffee halt at 11.15, and the lunch halt at 13.10. At any passage check along the route where there is a 'convoy' of cars arriving at the same time, to spread the convoy out, they will leave at one minute intervals.

The organisers will take a dim view of any driving standards, which may bring motor sport into disrepute, and will take appropriate action. Take your time and enjoy the sights.

Let's keep our fingers crossed for a warm, dry, sunny day to enjoy this beautiful part of England. See you on the day.
