Event postponed

Reason for postponement

The Hatsford Targa takes place on the fields of the Clerks estate. Recent weather has left the venue extremely dry, creating a significant fire risk. The organisers have monitored the forecast closely, but no meaningful rain is expected in time to reduce that risk. The Clerk was also made aware today of a fire in a neighbouring field that spread extremely quickly.

We do apologies for any inconvenience this may cause but, in these circumstances, postponing the event is the right and responsible course of action.

New event date and entries

The event is now scheduled to take place on Sunday 13 September.

Existing entries will be carried over to the new date. Should a crew not be available on the new date, they will receive a refund in full. Please e-mail simonharris8@outlook.com. Anyone who has previously withdrew but now available, may submit a fresh entry. Entries will re-open again on 31st July using the same link provided within the regulations.

The new closing date for seeded entries is 30th August at 2100 with final closing date for entries at on 9th September at 2100. Any later entries are at the discretion of the Clerk.

Final instructions will be mailed out on 6th September.

The event remains a round of the respective JD Tyres BTRDA Gold Star and Mikris Cotswold Targa Championships.
